Essential Functions

- Able to speak English
- Wash dishes, glassware, flatware, pots, pans, using commercial dishwasher, or by hand (in the event the dishwasher breaks down)
- Put away in the correct location all dishes and utensils
- Maintain kitchen work areas, equipment, or utensils in clean and orderly condition
- Clean or prepare various foods for cooking or serving
- Stock supplies, such as food or utensils, in serving stations, cupboards, refrigerators, or salad bars
- Sweep or scrub floors
- Clean garbage cans with water or steam
- Sort and remove trash, placing it in designated pickup areas
- Transfer supplies or equipment between storage and work areas, by hand, or using hand trucks
- Receive and store supplies in correct locations
